Information and Instructions for Nominator Please read carefully before submitting

The Awards & Condition of Eligibility:

- **Distinguished Alumni Awards:**

- Given to honor former students of HPISD whose achievements, strength of character and citizenship serve as models to inspire and challenge today's youth.
- Awarded for achievement in various fields of service which may include, but not limited to, the arts, athletics, business, education, entertainment, law, medicine, military, music, philanthropy, politics, public service, religion, scholarship and science.
- Open to any alumnus or alumna who attended Highland Park High School for a minimum of two (2) years, graduated from HPHS, and is at least 40 years of age at time of nomination.

- **Young Alumni Award:**

- Given to honor any alumnus or alumna who has achieved great success in their first 20 years after graduation.
- Awarded for achievement in various fields which may include, but are not limited to, the arts, athletics, business, education, entertainment, law, medicine, military, music, philanthropy, politics, public service, religion, scholarship, and science.
- Open to any alumnus or alumna who attended for a minimum of two (2) years and graduated from Highland Park High School.

- **Distinguished Service Award:**

- Given as a special award to honor a former faculty member and other individuals whose service to and support of the District has been outstanding.
- Open to faculty members who have completed at least ten (10) years of service to HPISD. At least two (2) years must have elapsed between the nominee's last full-time service to HPISD and the end of the school year in which the award is to be granted.

- **Highlander Award:**

- Given to an individual who has demonstrated significant commitment to the HPISD community through the giving of time, energy, and/or resources.
- Open to any person who's service to and support of HPISD must be outstanding.

Awards may be given posthumously, and in such instances, there shall be no age requirement.

- Attachments** – Please be concise
 - Additional documents may be attached to support the nomination form (vita/resume, newspaper or magazine clippings, etc.)
 - Photograph of the nominee, if available
- Cover Letter: Personal Statement of Recommendation**
 - Please state why you believe this individual should be considered for the nominated award.
- Support Letters** – minimum 3, no more than 10

Selection Procedure:

- An Awards Committee shall receive and review all nominations and select Award recipients.
- The committee may request further supportive documentation from a nominator.
- Each year, the Committee will award a combination of no more than five (5) total awards -
 - Three (3) Distinguished Alumni Awards
 - One (1) Young Alumni
 - One (1) Distinguished Service Award
 - One (1) Highlander Award
- The Awards Committee reserves the right to reject any or all nominations.
- Individuals nominated for an Award and not chosen shall be considered nominees for two (2) additional years, with the exception of the Young Alumni Award where nominations shall be considered for an additional (2) years or upon the 20th anniversary of the graduation date, whichever comes first. At that point the nomination will be tabled for at least a year and then the nominator may re-nominate that person for another three-year period.
