HPEF provides complete administration of your scholarship fund from publicizing the scholarship, creating, receiving, and processing the applications, convening the scholarship committee and everything in between. Donors may choose to be involved or not involved throughout the scholarship process. Please note that all scholarships are subject to the Foundation's Scholarship Selection Procedures.

Your Gift

HPEF only manages endowed scholarship funds. Endowed funds require a minimum initial gift of \$50,000 and are maintained in perpetuity. Funds must be in place for a minimum of one year before a scholarship distribution can be made. Scholarship distributions must be \$1,000 or greater.

Fees:

Scholarship Funds incur an annual 1% fee on the market value of the fund. Details of HPEF's fee policy may be found at hpef.org/financials.
